What is it	What it means	What to do
1. WHAT IS A PATTERN	A GROUP / MODEL of scales, arpeggios, similar runs of notes models, rhythms or articulation.	Patterns require SIMILAR ACTIONS with left or right hand so the brain can do them easily by MUSCLE MEMORY .
2. LEFT HAND – FINGER PATTERNS		
2a. SCALES – LIKE	Resembling a SCALE , or PART-SCALE , or a SCALE 'RUN' .	Identifying them as a scale - MAJOR, MINOR HARMONIC / MELODIC and remembering them as a PATTERN .
2b. ARPEGGIOS – LIKE	Resembling an ARPEGGIO , or PART-ARPEGGIO , or ARPEGGIO 'RUN' .	Identifying them as an arpeggio - MAJOR, MINOR, DOMINANT 7th, DIMINISHED 7th and remembering them as a PATTERN .
2c. MODEL RUNS OF REPEATED NOTES	Resembling runs of the same or similar note intervals, or turns making PATTERN MODELS .	Identifying them AS PATTERN MODELS and remembering them as a PATTERN .
3. RIGHT HAND – BOW PATTERNS		
3a. SAME RHYTHM	Resembling runs of the same RHYTHM MODEL .	Identifying them as a rhythm model – DOTTED RHYTHMS, GROUPS OF SEMIQUAVERS , and remembering them as a PATTERN .
3b. SAME ARTICULATION	Resembling REPEATED ARTICULATION MODELS – 2 slurs / 2 separated, same bow strokes, etc.	Identifying the models – SLURS / SEPARATED, BOW STROKE TYPES , and remembering them as a PATTERN .
